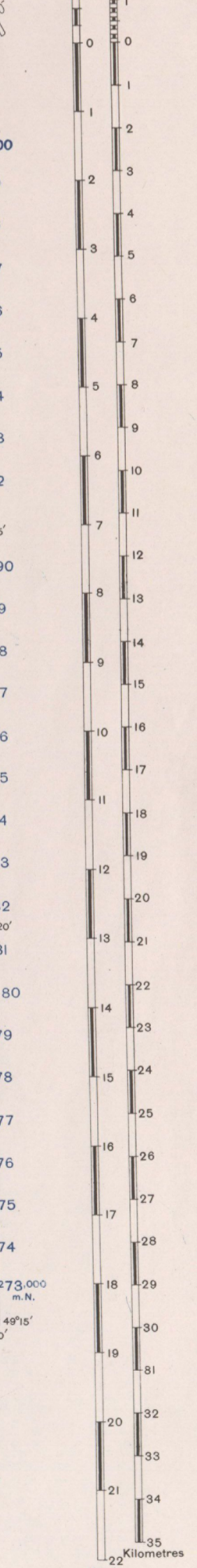


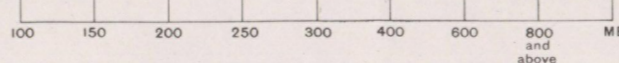
GERMAN GLOSSARY table listing German terms and their English equivalents, such as Abhang (Slope), Acker (Cultivation), and Berg (Mountain).

GRID DATA: Lambert (Modified) Conical Orthographic, 80 Grades N. & 8 Grades E. of Paris.

ROADS IN FRANCE, BELGIUM & LUXEMBOURG: Road classification is NOT based on reconnaissance. Reliability uncertain.

REFERENCE: Motor Highway, Railway, Main Roads, Secondary Roads, Paths, Causeways.

HEIGHTS IN METRES: Contour intervals 25 metres above 50 metres, 10 metres below 50 metres.

INDEX TO ADJOINING SHEETS: Table showing grid letters and numbers for adjacent map sheets.

COMPILED BY: Table listing the names and dates of the compilers for various years from 1928 to 1937.
