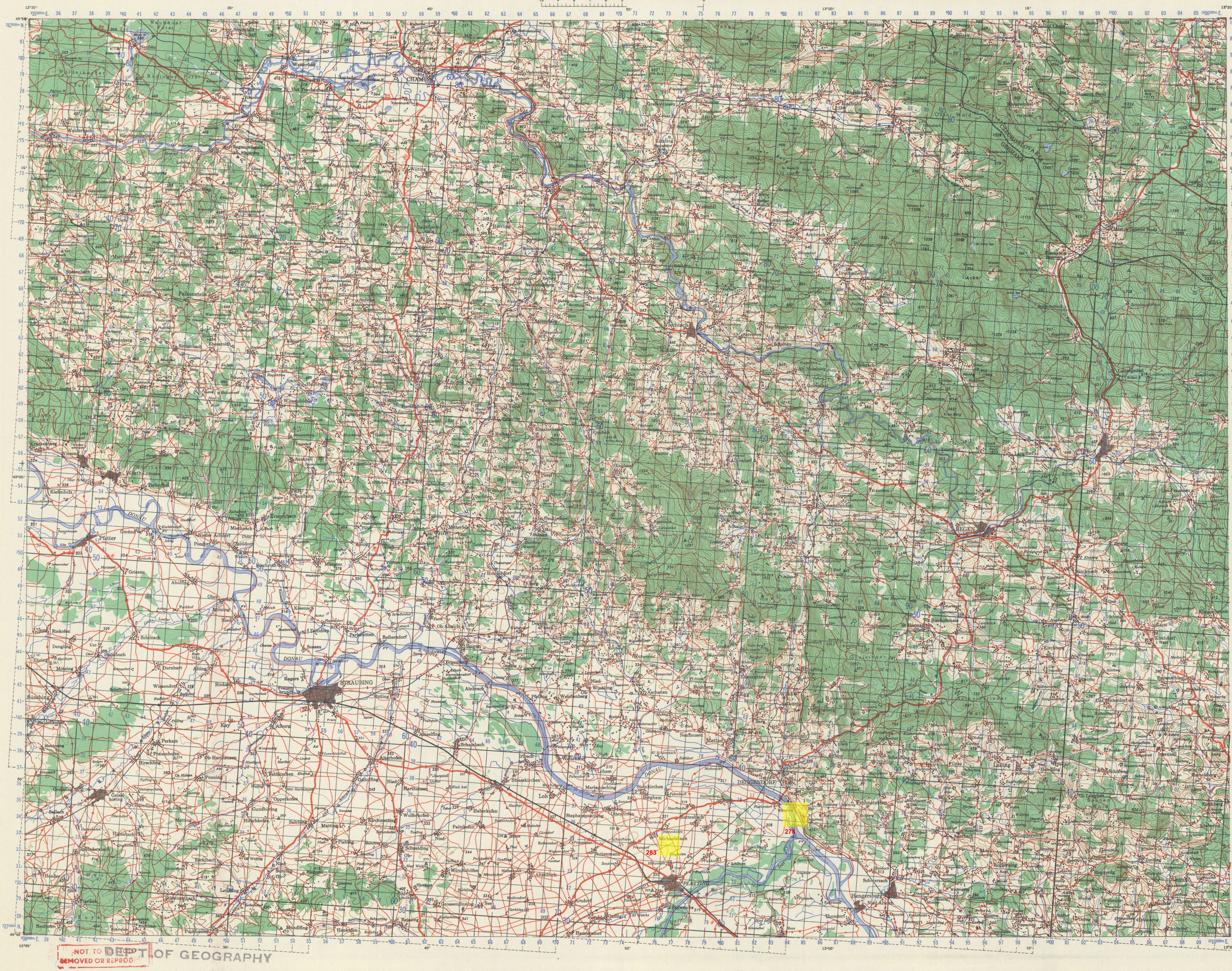

LEGEND

Red classification is NOT based on reconnaissance. Reliability uncertain.

Motor Highway. Independent of road system. Red dashed line with cross-ticks. 2 lanes, each with shoulder and 7.5 m. wide.

Connecting points with road system where known.

Main Roads. Metalled, mostly 6 m. wide (including footways). Other Main Roads. Metalled, 5.5 m. wide, average useful width 3.5 m. Secondary Roads. Metalled, 4 m. wide, average useful width 3 m. Other Roads and Cart Tracks. Not always metalled and often unsurfaced.

Paths. Multiple track (normal gauge) with station. Railway. Single track (normal gauge). Railway. Narrow gauge, tram, or spur track. Railway. Under construction.

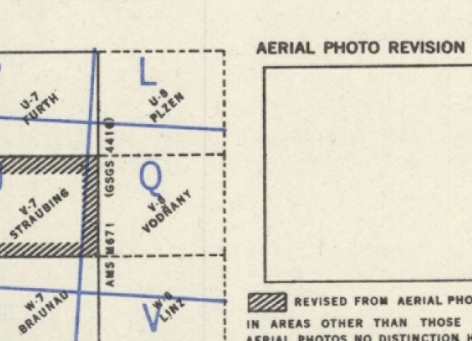

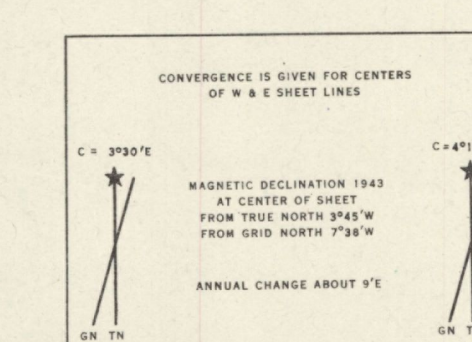
POLYCONIC PROJECTION

LETTER: Must be used for the sheet. One from top of map or from bottom. One from left edge of map or from right edge of map. One from top edge of map or from bottom edge of map. One from left edge of map or from right edge of map.

ONE FROM TOP OF MAP OR FROM BOTTOM. ONE FROM LEFT EDGE OF MAP OR FROM RIGHT EDGE OF MAP. ONE FROM TOP EDGE OF MAP OR FROM BOTTOM EDGE OF MAP. ONE FROM LEFT EDGE OF MAP OR FROM RIGHT EDGE OF MAP.
