- Reports of Burial have been received in this office covering the burials of Unknowns X-321 and X-322 in the U. S. Military Cemetery, Margraten, Holland.
- These bodies were recovered from a plane which crashed in the vicinity of Herrig, Germany on or about 12 March 1945. Information taken from plaque that was found on door of plane is as follows: Airplane Model-A -26, DWG. or Part no. 5122153-1, Modification -(019), Change -(S62), Incorporated - (AN K355) Number on hinge was: 11277679.
- It is requested that any information available from your records which may be of assistance in establishing the identity of the plane and members of the crew, be forwarded to this office at the earliest practicable date.



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

1. Reference is made to reports of burial for Unknowns X-321 and X-322, U. S. Military Cemetery, Margraten, Holland, Grave 25, Row 1, and Grave 26, Row 2, Plot HH, respectively. The remains were recovered from an A-26 plane, which crashed in the vicinity of Herrig, Germany, approximately 12 March 1945.

2. It is requested that this office be furnished a list of all A-26 planes known to have crashed in the area at that time, together with a complete list of the crew members and status of each, at the earliest practicable date.
