Oprep A Number 63 for 24 hours ending sunset 2 June 1944. Mission Number 64. IX Bomber Command Field Order Number 343.

Anti-aircraft fire was moderate inaccurate HFF from Vauchelles throughout bomb run and on left turn off target to St. Ricquier, 1 ship receiving category A damage. No enemy aircraft encountered. Planes landed at 2039.
