Upon completion of this activity, EM will ret to proper orgn and sta. TDN by MP, mil acft, or rail. While traveling, an allowance of five (\$5.00) dollars per day is atd if Govt qrs and rat are not available. FD will pay in advance an allowance of \$2.00 per day for rat and \$2.00 per day for qrs for seven (7) days in accordance w/ Policy 30-14, Hq USAAF, UK, 27 Dec 1943 and Par 3a and 3b, Cir 63, Hq ETOUSA, 5 June 1944. VOCCO on 27 May 1944, placing the following named EM, 669th Bomb Sq (L), on temp dy for two (2) days, WF o/a 27 May 1944, Thatcham, England, for the purpose of transporting personnel and supplies, upon completion of temp dy, to return to proper org and sta, authorizing EM, while traveling, an allowance of five (\$5.00) dollars per day, if Govt qrs and rat are not available, and authorizing EM, while on temp dy, reimbursement for actual cost of qrs not to exceed two (\$2.00) dollars per day if Govt qrs or billets are not available at temp dy sta, and reimbursement for actual cost of rat not to exceed two (\$2.00) dollars per day if Govt messing facilities are not available at temp dy sta, in accordance w/ Par 3, Cir 63, Hq ETOUS., 5 June 1944, and Par 8a, Policy 30-1 Hq USAAF, UL, 9 Nov 1943, TDN by MF, are hereby confirmed and made a matter of record.
