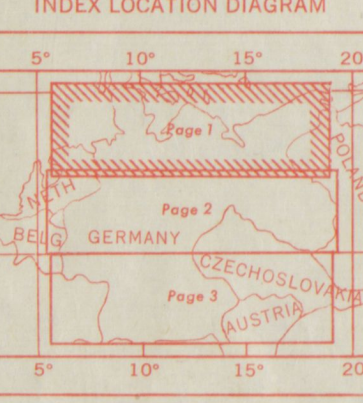

SERIES DESCRIPTION

TYPE: Topographic; set mixed: 3 of 4 color, or monochrome
with grid in color.

FORMAT: 8 1/2 x 10 1/2 E-W; sheets show 1,000 meter UTM
grid usually with 1,000 meter British grid as secondary. Bil-
lateral marginal data on UTM sheets.

SYMBOLS: German.

SOURCE: Copied by AMS from German original or GSGS
sheets, with some sheets Corps of Engineer compilations.

CHARACTERISTICS: Three administrative divisions
shown by boundaries; relief indicated by contours at 10 or 20
meter intervals; heights in meters; populated places shown by
black pattern with halftone, or building symbols; roads classi-
fied by importance and width and also surface on some sheets;
railroads shown as multiple or single track standard gauge, or
narrow gauge; vegetation symbolized; abbreviations and
elevation given on UTM sheets.

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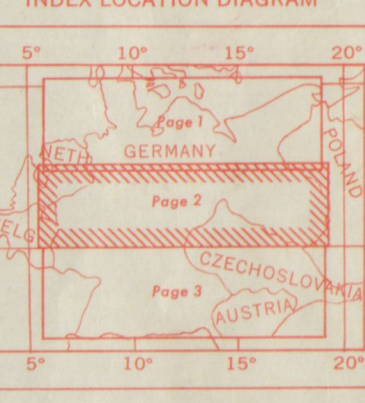
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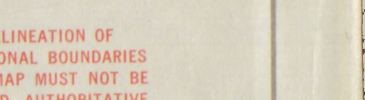
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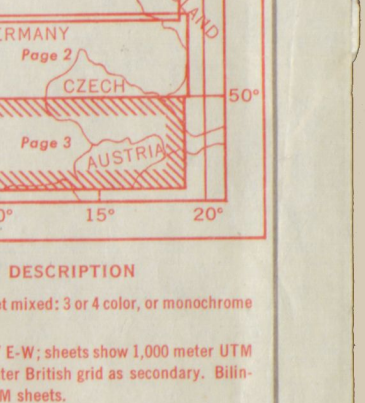
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
