**ROAD CLASSIFICATION (NT) BASED ON RECONNOISSANCE RELIABILITY UNIFORM**

Motor Highway (independent of road system) Reichsautobahn 2 lanes with each roadway 7.5 m. wide.

Connecting points with road system where known.

Under construction

Main Roads: Reichstrassen with route numbers. Metalled and mostly 4 m. wide.

Other Main Roads (mostly Landstrassen I, Ordnung metalled and 4.5 m. average useful width.

Secondary Roads: Metalled and 4 m. average useful width. Other Roads and Cart Tracks: Not always metalled and often unmetalled.

Falls: Multiple track (normal gauge) with station.

Railway: Single track (normal gauge).

Railway: Narrow gauge, tram, or spur track.

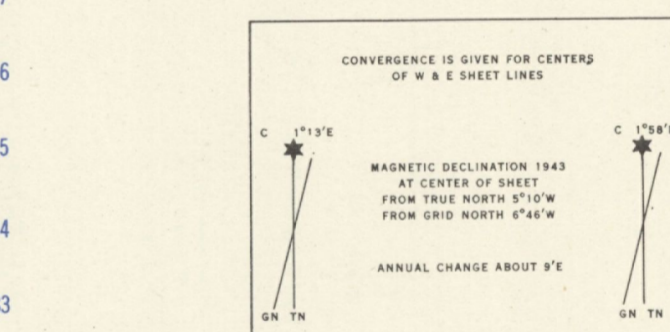
