The attached photographs of this cemetery were taken prior to the exhumation, casketing, and relocation of the remains interred therein, in accordance with the program for the Return of World War II Dead.

Please be assured of my continued sympathy in your great loss.





Dear Mrs. Young:

This is in reply to your letter in which you request information concerning your son, Staff Sergeant Clay E. Young.

Your desire to learn as much as possible regarding the death of your son is most understandable. Information available in the War Department reveals that Sergeant Young, who was the mechanic gunner, was one of three crew members of an A-20 (Havoc) bomber which departed from its base at Wethersfield, Essex, England on a bomberdment mission to Zuid Beveland Island, Netherlands on 16 September 1944. During this mission at about 6:15 p.m. while over Coster Schelde Bay, Holland, your son's bomber sustained demage from enemy flak and was seen to go down in flames, crashing into the water about one quarter of a mile from land. Two parachutes were seen to emerge from the disabled craft and drift toward Bergen op Zoom, Holland. Since the status and whereabouts of your son were unknown following this mission, he was reported missing in action on 16 September 1944.

Sergeant Young remained in a missing status until an official report was received from the German Government through the International Red Cross that he was killed in action on 16 September 1944. No additional details were given.

In an effort to obtain all available details concerning the deaths of our military personnel reported by the German Government, several volumes of captured German records have been translated. These records confirm the death of Sergeant Young on 16 September 1944 and record the place of death as Rilland (51° 25' North, 4° 12' East), Holland. It is also recorded that he was interred at Bergen op Zoom (51° 30' North, 4° 18' East), Holland, about eight miles from Rilland.



I have received your letter of 30 August 1946, with inclosure, concerning your son, the late Staff Sergeant Clay E. Young.

The feelings which prompted your communication are most understandable, and I deeply regret that so much sorrow has come to you. No information regarding Sergeant Young has been received other than that conveyed to you in General Witsell's letter of 2 August 1945.

With respect to the photograph mentioned in your letter, I must advise you that this office has no way of identifying pictures or photographs of military personnel appearing in newsreels, magazines and newspapers. The War Department has investigated the possibility of making positive identification of the subjects of phhtographs of this type and its experience indicated that the matter is largely one of opinion and consequent uncertainty and that it is generally possible to obtain multiple identification of each subject appearing in the picture.

The Quartermaster General, Washington 25, D. C., has jurisdiction over all matters pertaining to the burial of our Army personnel who die while serving overseas, therefore, I am referring a copy of your letter to that official for further direct reply to you.

Your loss is irreparable and your grief is great I know. While I realize there is little I can say to assuage your sorrow, I trust that the cherished memories of your son's heroic desction to duty may sustain and comfort you.

On Saturday, 16 September 1944 at about 6 to 7 o'clock in the evening about 4 groups of an ample 18 planes came across. Among the second group of planes, one plane was hit. The plane crashed burning into the Schelde river. I suppose that the plane crashed between Rilland-Bath and Tholen. Nobody in this town saw parachutists. The concerned plane was a two motor-plane. I do not know anything about the crew of the plane.

I do not know anything about the concerned American soldier S/Sgt Clay E. Young, 17129222 who should have died in this commune at this plane accident.






